



2019 - 2020 school year **The Seven Hills School Immunization Information Sheet**

Please note that these are only the ODH minimum requirements and are not considered the full complement of recommended immunizations for children.

1) Diphtheria, Pertussis, & Tetanus:

Preschool – 4 doses of DTaP or DT or any combination

Kindergarten – 4 or more doses of DTaP or DT, or any combination. If the fourth dose was given at least six months after the third dose, and on or after the 4th birthday, a 5th dose is not required.

Grades 1-12 – 4 or more doses of DTaP or DT, or any combination. Three (3) doses of Td & Tdap is the minimum acceptable for children age 7 & up.

Grade 7 – 12 – 1 dose of Tdap vaccine must be administered prior to entry.

2) Polio:

Preschool – 3 doses of OPV or IPV or any combination of OPV or IPV.

Kindergarten – 9 – 3 or more doses of IPV; the FINAL dose in the IPV series must be administered on or after the 4th birthday regardless of the previous number of doses, with at least six months between it and the previous dose. If a combination of OVP and IVP was received, 4 doses of either vaccine are required.

Grades 10 -12 – 3 or more doses of OPV or IPV. If the third does of either series was received prior to the fourth birthday, a fourth dose is required; If a combination of OPV and IPV was received, 4 doses of either vaccine are required.

3) Measles, Mumps & Rubella:

These vaccines may be given separately if medically necessary but are typically given together in one shot known as the MMR.

Preschool – 1 dose given on or after the first birthday

Grades K – 12 - Two doses of the MMR are required. The first dose must have been administered on or after the first birthday with the second dose at least 28 days later.

4) Hepatitis B:

Preschool – 12 - all shall be required to provide evidence of having received a three-dose series of the Hepatitis B vaccine. The second dose must be given at least 28 days after the first and the third dose at least 16 weeks after the first & at least 8 weeks after the second. The last dose in the series (third or fourth dose) must not be administered before age 24 weeks.

5) Haemophilus b (HIB):

Preschool – 3 to 4 doses depending on the vaccine type, the age when the child began the 1st dose and the last dose must be after 12 months

Or 1 dose given on or after 15 months of age

6) Varicella (Chicken Pox) Vaccine

Preschool – 1 dose of Varicella administered on or after the first birthday

Kindergarten – 9 – 2 doses of varicella vaccine must be administered prior to entry. Dose 1 must be administered on or after the 1st birthday. The 2nd dose should be administered at least 3 months after dose 1; however, if the 2nd dose is at least 28 days after the 1st dose, it is considered valid.

Grades 10 - 12 – 1 dose of varicella vaccine must be administered on or after the 1st birthday.

7) MCV4 (Meningococcal)

Grade 7 - 10 – 1 dose of meningococcal vaccine (serogroup A, C, W & Y) must be administered prior to entry

Grade 12 – 2 doses of meningococcal vaccine (serogroup A, C, W & Y) must be administered prior to entry. Minimum 8 weeks between doses. If 1st dose after 16th birthday, only 1 dose required. If a 12th grade pupil is 15 yo or younger, only 1 dose is required.
