

## Directions for Seven Hills Medical Forms

**Emergency Medical Authorization (EMA)** - this must be updated every year for all students

The EMA contains the following information:

- Physician/Dentist/Insurance Information and allergy/medical history
- Emergency Contact Information
- Tuberculosis screening information

### **Medical Record (MR)**

The Medical Record is a form for the student's physician.

A completed medical record is required for:

- All new students - current medical record with immunizations
- All Pre-K students - annual medical record required with a doctor's signature - see "Date of Last Physical Exam" on the Medical Record form
- All KDG students - updated immunizations required - see Ohio Department of Health (ODH) immunization guidelines for more details
- All 7th-12th grade students - need proof of current Tdap prior to entry
- All 7th-10th grade students need proof of 1 dose of Meningococcal prior to entry
- All 12th grade students - need proof of 2 doses of Meningococcal prior to entry
- All other students - required if any new immunizations or changes

### **Consent to Administer Medication at School**

This form is required for the administration of Acetaminophen (Tylenol) or Ibuprofen (Advil).

Please note: This form requires signatures from an MD and a parent/guardian. The form for Lower School students is different than the form for Middle and Upper students.
